# Regulations

## 1.GENERAL PROVISIONS

#### 1.1. Game format

The tournament is held on 18 holes, in 1 game round, in the game format at the expense of strokes, taking into account the handicap, the results are calculated in the format of team Scramble according to:

- Golf Rules approved by R&A Rules Limited,
- Local rules,
- Standards and Code of Conduct,
- Requirements for the pace of the game,
- Tournament Regulations,
- these Conditions.
- 1.1.1. Scramble is a team of two people, each of the partners starts the game on the hole with his ball, then the team decides which of the balls is in the best position, and from this place both players continue the game, and so on until they finish the hole..
  - 1.1.2. Calculation of team handicaps:

Game handicap of the team = 30% of the game handicap of a player with a higher handicap index + 70% of the game handicap of a player with a lower handicap index.

## 1.1.3. Playing those

a. Men start from the yellow onesb. Women start from the red ones

c. The start is simultaneous, from **10:30** 

d. Saturday, August 22: the start sequence is determined by the Tournament Committee.

# 1.2. Requirements for participants

- a. Registration for the tournament:
- players must have a current WHS handicap (hereinafter, when using the term "handicap" only the WHS handicap is meant), <a href="https://www.ukrgolf.org/gandikapi/gandikapi\_gravciv">https://www.ukrgolf.org/gandikapi/gandikapi\_gravciv</a>
  - the value of the playing handicap player is limited 26.0.

 $\it Note: Admission of players who do not have a current WHS handicap is considered by the Tournament Committee individually.$ 

- b. Players must meet the amateur status requirements set forth and approved by R&A Rules Limited.
- c. Players committed thus take part in the tournament *on a general basis*.
- d. Players are allowed to use golf machines.

# 1.3. Number of participants

The maximum number of participants is 72.

## 1.4. Heads drivers / Allowed balls

Current interpretation of the R&A Golf Rules.

Rule 4, section 4.1 "Sticks", p. 29, edition of UFG.

Rule 4, Section 4.2 "Balls", p. 36, edition of UFG.

#### 1.5. Stop the game due to a dangerous situation

A signal to stop the game in case of danger situation Signal for all other game stops

Signal to restore the game

- ONE LONG BEEP siren;
- THREE SHORT CONSECUTIVE SIRENE BOWS;
- TWO SHORT SIRENE BOWS.

# 1.6. Solving equal results

Equal results on any position of the final protocol are solved, according to the algorithm of calculation of results of ESOG "DATAGOLF".

*Note:* The committee has the right to decide equality by drawing lots.

#### 1.7. Return of debit cards

R&A Golf Rules, Section 3.3, p. 24, edition of UFG.

The Player MUST PERSONALLY return his / her debit card to the place designated by the Tournament Committee as the referee's office. The score card is considered returned when the player leaves the referee's office.

*Note:* if a player, without good reason, does not personally return his account card, the player is subject to a penalty for violation of the "Standards and Code of Conduct" in the form of disqualification.

## 1.8. Competition protocol / Competition is over

The results of the competition are officially announced, and the competition is completed when the final protocol is announced at the award ceremony. Any discrepancies and conflicting issues with the R&A Golf Rules must be referred to the Tournament Committee before the end of the game but no later than 15 minutes after the end of the game.

#### 1.9. Anti-doping

All players are subject to strict anti-doping rules established by the International Golf Federation (IGF) and published on the official website www.igfgolf.org, in the section "Medical & Anti-Doping". Players who take medication and have doubts about their medical condition should seek advice from the UFG office, NO LATER THAN 30 DAYS BEFORE THE COMPETITION.

#### 2.COMMITTEE

## 2.1. Composition

The Tournament Committee is responsible for the sporting aspects of the competition and has the right to amend these Terms. The Committee may appoint persons to the Tournament Committee with or without the right to make a final decision..

## 2.2. Cancel and change of the competition date

The Tournament Committee has the right to reduce the number or cancel any regulated round, suspend or postpone the game, cancel the competition or make an appropriate decision to get a fair result..

Participation fee:

The cost of participation in the tournament is 2000 hryvnias per player;

The cost of participation in the tournament for juniors (under 18) is free;

The cost of participation in the tournament includes:

green phi for the qualifying round;

training on Driving, Chipping and Putting platforms in game days Training on Driving, Chipping and Putting platforms in game days; organizational fee;

medals, diplomas, prizes and gifts.

Sneakers, trolleys, golf cars approved by the Committee, and equipment rental according to the host club's price list.

# 4. RESULTS

# 4.1. The team consists of two people:

For the first place

Receive the Cup

For second place is Cup

For third place is Cup

## 4.2. Prizes

The following nominations are distinguished:

- a. Nomination gross team is excluding handicap.
- b. Longest Drive total credit.
- c. Nearest to the Pin total credit.

*Note:* the final number of nominees is determined by the actual availability of prizes and gifts from sponsors on the day of the award ceremony.

# 4.7. WHS handicap system (handicap conversion)

The results of the round are not qualifying in terms of the WHS handicap system.

## 5.PARTICIPANTS' RISKS

All tournament participants are aware that there are certain risks associated with the game of golf, and take full responsibility for the consequences.

All available applications, certificates, permits, recommendations, reports and other documents must be submitted to the Tournament Committee before registration.

Players are "recommended" to provide a medical certificate prior to the start of the competition stating that the player is allowed

to play golf and participate in the Tournament, as well as to list the restrictions provided (or recommended) by a doctor.

After confirming the player registration to participate in the Tournament, it is considered that he / she is familiar with and agrees to comply with the requirements of the "Standards and Code of Conduct".
